Durleigh Parish Council need a new Councillor. Could this be you? Are you interested in serving your local community? Do you want to represent the community on upcoming/future matters?

We still have a councillor vacancy to Co-opt someone onto the council. The new parish councillor will fill a vacancy in the Wyndham Ward (although as the Council is grouped, councillors represent the whole community of Durleigh).

The Council meets 6 times a year, usually on the second Thursday of the month (Jan, Mar, May, Jul, Sep, Nov), at Westfield Church.

Parish Councillors volunteer their time to work on behalf of their local community. If you have lived in the Parish, or within 3 miles of it, for at least a year and are over 18, you are probably eligible (please check with the clerk for further eligibility criteria). Training will be available, funded by the Parish Council.
